Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

3	I. The board shall establish fees for examination of applicants, for licenses and for renewal of
4	licenses to practice pharmacy, for registration and certification of pharmacy technicians, and for
5	transcribing and transferring records and other services.
6	II. The fee for restoration of a suspended, revoked, or voluntarily surrendered
7	license, registration, or certification under this chapter shall not include the assessment of
8	charges or renewal fees for the period in which the licensee, registrant, or certificate
9	holder was not permitted to practice in this state.
10	10:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
