HOUSE BILL **238**

AN ACT relative to the energy efficiency implementation plan.

SPONSORS: Rep. Mann, Ches 2; Sen. Fuller Clark, Dist 21

COMMITTEE: Science, Technology and Energy

ANALYSIS

This bill requires the office of energy and planning to include consideration of certain factors when developing the energy efficiency implementation plan.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to the energy efficiency implementation plan.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Energy Efficiency Implementation Plan. Amend 2014, 267:2 by inserting
2 after paragraph II the following new paragraph:

3 III. In developing the energy efficiency implementation plan, the office of energy and
4 planning shall consider the following:

5 (a) Desired rate of achieving all cost-effective energy efficiency.

6 (b) The possible sources of funding including loan guarantees.

7 (c) Possible impacts on the economy as a result of implementing energy efficiency
8 programs.

9 (d) The need for stability of state energy efficiency policy over time in order to achieve
10 the objectives of the plan, as well as how to obtain such stability.

11 (e) The rate at which a competent cadre of workers can be trained in order to implement
12 energy efficiency programs.

13 (f) Ways to obtain public awareness and support for energy efficiency programs.

14 (g) Optimal organizational options for achieving energy efficiency goals.

15 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
