 This bill sets the permissible level of methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE) in drinking water at 0 parts per billion.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to the permissible level of methyl tertiary butyl ether in drinking water.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Methyl Tertiary Butyl Ether (MTBE); Drinking Water Standards. RSA 485:16-a is repealed
- 2 and reenacted to read as follows:
- 3 485:16-a Drinking Water Standards. No public water system shall deliver water with greater
- 4 than 0 parts per billion methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE).
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
