The members of the committee shall be as follows: 5 (a) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the 6 house of representatives. 7 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate. 8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to the duties of the committee. 9 10 The committee shall study the adoption of low-impact housing development 11 standards by the department of environmental services. 12 3:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from 13 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house 14 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this 15 section. 16 3:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed 17 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house 18 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2015. 19 3:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
