AN ACT                   relative to town clerk fees for fill and dredge permit applications.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           1 Excavating and Dredging Permit; Certain Exemptions. Amend RSA 482-A:3, I(a)(1) to read as  
2 follows:

3                   (1) A complete application form that has been signed by the town or city clerk of the  
4 municipality in which the property is located or, if the property is located in more than one  
5 municipality, by the city or town clerk of each such municipality, certifying that the municipality has  
6 received 4 copies of the form and attachments as provided in subparagraph (a)(2). The town or city  
7 clerk shall send a copy of the form and attachments to the local governing body, the municipal  
8 planning board, if any, and the municipal conservation commission, if any, and shall retain one copy  
9 to be made reasonably accessible to the public ***and may require an administrative fee not to***  
10 ***exceed \$10 plus the cost of postage by certified mail.*** Applications and fees for projects by  
11 agencies of the state may be filed directly with the department, with 4 copies of the application, plan,  
12 and map filed at the same time with the town or city clerk.

13           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
