Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

Require school districts to adopt a policy permitting a 3 pupil's parent or legal guardian to observe his or her classes upon request to the school principal or 4 5 designee. 6
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
