HOUSE BILL **302**

AN ACT requiring a public hearing prior to the submission of a grant application by the department of education.

This bill requires the department of education to submit all grant applications to the house of representatives committee concerned with educational issues for a public hearing and comments.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT requiring a public hearing prior to the submission of a grant application by the department of education.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Duties of the Commissioner; Department of Education. Amend RSA 21-N:4, VI to read as
2 follows:

3 VI. Plan and apply for federal and other grants on a department-wide basis. ***Prior to the***
4 ***submission of any grant application, the commissioner shall notify the chair of the***
5 ***committee of the house of representatives with primary responsibility for education issues.***
6 ***The chair of such committee shall schedule and hold a public hearing on the application***
7 ***and shall forward all testimony to the commissioner along with comments by members of***
8 ***the committee. The commissioner shall review the testimony and comments prior to the***
9 ***submission of the corresponding grant application.***

10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
