Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Withdrawal. Amend RSA 655:30 to read as follows:

655:30 Withdrawal. When a party candidate has duly filed according to law for nomination at a primary election, or other candidate has submitted nomination papers, no withdrawal or declination of the candidate shall be accepted by the secretary of state subsequent to the [last dates] Wednesday following the expiration of the period for filing a declaration of candidacy as provided in RSA 655:31 and 655:34.

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
