Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

Any public utility that fails to provide the information in paragraph I at the time of a rate increase filing shall be denied the rate increase until such information is 1920provided. 21III. The commission shall review the bad debt of utility customers to ensure that the 22utilities are able to make the best effort to collect a debt before using a bad debt as a basis 23for a rate increase. 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage. 24
