AN ACT relative to the closing of clam, oyster, and other bivalve areas for restoration.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 110:1 New Section; Fish and Game; Taking of Bivalves; Closing for Restoration. Amend RSA 2 211 by inserting after section 63-a the following new section: 211:63-b Closing for Restoration. The executive director, after a public hearing, may order a 3 closing of clam, oyster, and other bivalve areas for the purpose of restoration of the area, provided 4 that the closure will not unduly interfere with existing or anticipated commercial or recreational 5 activities. When such closing for restoration is ordered, the order shall be effective immediately 6 7 without a waiting period and shall continue in effect for a period of not more than 5 years. No more 8 than 50 acres shall be closed at any time. 9
