This bill provides that any regulated public utility that fails to restore service to its customers within 3 days shall be liable for damages sustained by the customer.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 General Public Utility Duty; Service; Liability. Amend RSA 374:1 to read as follows:
2	374:1 Service; Liability.
3	I. Every public utility shall furnish such service and facilities as shall be reasonably safe and
4	adequate and in all other respects just and reasonable.
5	II. Except following a declared state of emergency, any public utility that fails to
6	restore service within 3 days shall be liable for damages sustained by the customer than
7	were caused by such utility's failure to restore service by such date.
