STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT establishing the red-tailed hawk as the New Hampshire state raptor.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Section; State Raptor. Amend RSA 3 by inserting after section 27 the following new
2 section:
3 3:28 State Raptor. The red-tailed hawk, *Buteo jamaicensis*, is hereby declared to be the state
4 raptor of New Hampshire.
5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
