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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen

AN ACT establishing a committee to study facilitating private investment in energy efficiency and renewable energy.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 68:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study facilitating private
2 investment in energy efficiency and renewable energy.

3 68:2 Membership and Compensation.

4 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5 (a) Four members of the house of representatives, one of whom shall be from the science,
6 technology and energy committee, one of whom shall be from the resources, recreation and
7 development committee, one of whom shall be from the commerce and consumer affairs committee,
8 and one of whom shall be from the finance committee, appointed by the speaker of the house of
9 representatives.

10 (b) One member of the senate, who shall be a member of the energy and natural
11 resources committee, appointed by the president of the senate.

12 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
13 the duties of the committee.

14 68:3 Duties. The committee shall study facilitating private investment in energy efficiency and
15 renewable energy. The committee shall identify the statutory changes necessary to facilitate such
16 private investment.

17 68:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
18 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house
19 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
20 section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

21 68:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
22 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
23 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2015.

24 68:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
