STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen*

AN ACT                    establishing a committee to study the classifications of military vehicles and equipment that may be purchased by the state and its political subdivisions and establishing a committee to study honorary legislation.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            232:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study the classifications of  
2 military vehicles and equipment that may be purchased by the state and its political subdivisions.

3            232:2 Membership and Compensation.

4            I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5                    (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house  
6 of representatives.

7                    (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

8            II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to  
9 the duties of the committee.

10           232:3 Duties. The committee shall study the classifications of military vehicles and equipment  
11 and determine which classifications the state and its political subdivision may purchase or continue  
12 to own.

13           232:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson  
14 from among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named  
15 house member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date  
16 of this section.

17           232:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed  
18 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house  
19 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2016.

20           232:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
