ANALYSIS

This bill bans manufactured corn-based ethanol for use in gasoline.

This bill also bans the sale of gasoline containing corn-based ethanol as an additive in New Hampshire.

HB 409 - AS INTRODUCED

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen

AN ACT banning corn-based ethanol as an additive to gasoline in New Hampshire. Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Corn-Based Ethanol Banned. Amend RSA 260:38, III to read as follows: 1 $\mathbf{2}$ III. Each person manufacturing alcohol, ethanol, methanol, or any other product within the 3 state of New Hampshire for use in gasohol shall obtain a license and, on or before the twentieth day of each calendar month, the sole proprietor, president, managing partner, chief executive officer, or 4 $\mathbf{5}$ equivalent thereof, of said person shall render a return to the commissioner on forms prescribed and 6 furnished by the commissioner, and shall certify under the pains and penalties of perjury that the 7return is true, accurate, and complete in all material respects. The return shall show the total 8 number of gallons sold to distributors of gasohol, or to persons purchasing the product for the 9 purpose of resale to the distributors, together with such other information as the commissioner may 10 require for the reasonable administration of this subdivision. No licensee shall manufacture corn-based ethanol for use in gasoline in this state. 11 122 New Section; Corn-Based Ethanol Prohibited. Amend RSA 339-B by inserting after section 8 13the following new section: 14339-B:8-a Corn-Based Ethanol Prohibited. No seller of gasoline shall sell or offer for sale gasoline that contains corn-based ethanol as an additive. 15Contingency. Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall take effect upon certification by the 163 17commissioner of the department of environmental services to the secretary of state and the director of the office of legislative services that at least 2 of the 6 New England states have adopted similar 1819legislation banning corn-based ethanol as an additive to gasoline.
