# HB 445 - AS INTRODUCED

#### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen

AN ACT defining poker as a game of skill.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 Poker. Amend RSA 647:2, II(d) to read as follows:
2	(d) "Gambling" means to risk something of value upon a future contingent event not
3	under one's control or influence, upon an agreement or understanding that something of value will
4	be received in the event of a certain outcome. For the purposes of this subparagraph, the phrase
<b>5</b>	"something of value" shall include a sweepstakes ticket or other item obtained in conjunction with
6	the purchase of goods or services that entitles the holder to a share or chance in a sweepstakes
7	where, but for the opportunity to enter the sweepstakes, the value of purchased goods or services is
8	insufficient to justify the purchase or the inducement to purchase the goods or services is the
9	opportunity to play on a gambling machine. For purposes of this section, games of poker shall
10	not be considered gambling and shall be considered a game of skill.
11	2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
