HOUSE BILL **459**

AN ACT establishing a committee to study medical services provided to residents of the New Hampshire veterans' home.

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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen

AN ACT establishing a committee to study medical services provided to residents of the
New Hampshire veterans' home.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study medical services provided
2 to residents of the New Hampshire veterans' home.

3 2 Membership and Compensation.

4 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5 (a) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
6 house of representatives.

7 (b) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
9 the duties of the committee.

10 3 Duties. The committee shall study medical services provided to residents of the
11 New Hampshire veterans' home. The committee shall examine laws, rules, and regulations
12 governing the provision of such medical services and the possible certification of the veterans' home
13 by the department of health and human services.

14 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
15 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house
16 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
17 section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

18 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
19 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
20 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2015.

21 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
