Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Right of Accused; Jury Nullification. RSA 519:23-a is repealed and reenacted to read as

 3 519:23-a Right of Accused; Jury Nullification. In all court proceedings the court shall instruct
 4 the jury of its inherent right to judge the law as well as the facts and to nullify any and all actions it
 5 finds to be unjust. The court shall allow the defendant or counsel for the defendant to explain this
 6 right of jury nullification to the jury.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
