Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

No person, without the written authorization of the owner of a burial plot, or the lineal 4 descendant or ascendant of the deceased, if such owner or lineal descendant or ascendant is known, or the written authorization of the governing board of the municipality in which the burial 5 6 plot lies, if the owner or lineal descendant or ascendant is unknown, shall: 7 95:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage. 8 9 Approved: June 5, 2015
