Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 3 VII. Notwithstanding any requirement of the 2014 National Electric Code, as amended, the
- 4 state building code review board shall not adopt or enforce any rule requiring the installation of arc-
- 5 fault circuit-interrupter protection in any new residential construction project.
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2016.
