Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

113:1 Original and Youth Operators' Licenses. Amend RSA 263:14, V to read as follows: 1 $\mathbf{2}$ V. In addition to the other requirements of this section, the holder of a youth operator's license who is convicted of an offense under [RSA 265:80, RSA 265:82, or RSA 265:82-a] RSA 265-A 3 shall not be eligible for reissuance of a license prior to the age of 21 unless the person satisfies the 4 director after an administrative hearing that the person will drive in a safe manner if the license is $\mathbf{5}$ 6 issued. The director may place such restrictions on any license so issued as the director deems in the 7best interest of public safety. 8 113:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage. 9
