SENATE BILL **82**

AN ACT relative to the authority of the commissioner of the department of education.

ANALYSIS

This bill prohibits the commissioner of the department of education from initiating or assuming any managerial, supervisory, or operational function, or directing action with district superintendents, principals, or CIA (curriculum, instruction, and assessment), and prohibits the commissioner from initiating or establishing district oversight through an extended cabinet of regional liaisons.

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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to the authority of the commissioner of the department of education.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Department of Education; Duties of Commissioner. Amend RSA 21-N:4 by
2 inserting after paragraph XI the following new paragraph:

3 XII. Not initiate or assume any managerial, supervisory, or operational function, or direct
4 action with district superintendents, principals, or CIA (curriculum, instruction, and assessment),
5 nor initiate or establish district oversight through an extended cabinet of regional liaisons.

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
