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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen

AN ACT establishing a committee to study public-private partnerships for intermodal transportation.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 184:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study public-private
2 partnerships for intermodal transportation.

3 184:2 Membership and Compensation.

4 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5 (a) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

6 (b) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
7 house of representatives.

8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
9 the duties of the committee.

10 184:3 Duties. The committee shall study the possibilities and propose legislation for forming
11 public-private partnerships for intermodal transportation.

12 184:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson
13 from among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named
14 senate member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date
15 of this section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

16 184:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
17 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate
18 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before January 1, 2016.

19 184:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
