- I. No person shall smoke tobacco products in a motor vehicle at any time when a child under the age of 18 is in the vehicle.
 - II. The fine for a violation of this section shall be \$100.
 - III. Enforcement of this section by law enforcement agencies shall be accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been cited or charged with a violation or some other offense.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 120 days after its passage.
