STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen*

AN ACT                    establishing a committee to study issues concerning parking for those with walking disabilities.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            155:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study issues concerning  
2 parking for those with walking disabilities.

3            155:2 Membership and Compensation.

4            I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5                    (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house  
6 of representatives, 2 of whom shall be from the health, human services and elderly affairs  
7 committee, one of whom shall be from the transportation committee, and one of whom shall be from  
8 the municipal and county government committee.

9                    (b) One senator appointed by the president of the senate.

10           155:3 Duties. The committee shall study issues concerning parking for those with walking  
11 disabilities including reviewing RSA 265:73 – RSA 265:74-a and any applicable administrative rules.  
12 The committee may also consider any recommendations or suggestions relative to disabled persons  
13 or specifically to walking disabilities that come before the committee.

14           155:4 Chairperson. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from among  
15 the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the senate member. The first  
16 meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section.

17           155:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed  
18 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate  
19 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2015.

20           155:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
