AN ACT                    establishing a committee to study limiting the sulfur content of liquid fuels.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            37:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study limiting the sulfur  
2 content of liquid fuels.

3            37:2 Membership and Compensation.

4            I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5                    (a) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

6                    (b) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house  
7 of representatives.

8            II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to  
9 the duties of the committee.

10          37:3 Duties. The committee shall study limiting the sulfur content of liquid fuels.

11          37:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from  
12 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the senate member. The  
13 first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section. Three  
14 members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

15          37:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed  
16 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate  
17 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2016.

18          37:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
