SENATE BILL **245**

AN ACT establishing a committee to study occupational regulatory boards and commissions.

SPONSORS: Sen. Prescott, Dist 23

ANALYSIS

This bill establishes a committee to study occupational regulatory boards and commissions.

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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen

AN ACT establishing a committee to study occupational regulatory boards and commissions.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study occupational regulatory
2 boards and commissions.

3 2 Membership and Compensation.

4 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5 (a) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

6 (b) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
7 house of representatives.

8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
9 the duties of the committee.

10 3 Duties. The committee shall study occupational regulatory boards and commissions, and shall
11 specifically review:

12 I. The education, training, and experience requirements for applications and issuance of
13 licenses, certifications, and registrations.

14 II. The costs for issuance, renewals, and required continuing education for licenses,
15 certifications, and registrations.

16 III. Requirements for membership or certification by professional or industry associations.

17 IV. Oversight mechanisms for each board or commission.

18 V. Any matter the committee deems relevant to its study.

19 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
20 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named senate
21 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
22 section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

23 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
24 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate
25 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2016.

26 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
