## How to register support/opposition on a bill

To register support or opposition on a bill that has a public hearing scheduled, you will utilize the sign-in form located on the general court website available here: <a href="http://gencourt.state.nh.us/house/committees/remotetestimony/default.aspx">http://gencourt.state.nh.us/house/committees/remotetestimony/default.aspx</a> You are encouraged to sign in well in advance of the hearing.

This online form will allow you to sign in on a bill as soon as it has been scheduled for a hearing. If no hearings are scheduled, no positions can be registered.

- 1. Click on the date that the bill you are interested in is being heard.
- 2. Under the drop-down menus.
  - a. Select the committee that is hearing the bill.
  - b. Select the bill you are interested in.
  - c. Select a category (elected official, lobbyist, agency staff, member of the public).
- 3. If you are representing an entity or someone other than yourself, enter that information in the box.
- 4. Indicate whether you support, oppose or are neutral on the bill by checking the appropriate circle.
- 5. Click continue.
- 6. Enter your name and contact information.
- 7. Click continue.
- 8. Carefully review that the information you have entered is correct. If it is correct, check the box and click continue. This completes the sign in process.
- 9. The sign in list will be compiled for all bills being heard by the committee on a given day 30 minutes prior to the start of the first hearing. If you sign up after that time, the Chair will not have your name before them.

## How to submit written testimony

Written testimony should be submitted to the committee e-mail which will be forwarded to the entire committee. If you have signed up to testify or register your opinion on a bill, the confirmation page will include instructions for submitting testimony. You may also utilize the "Email All Committee Members" link found on the relevant committee web page.
