The Department of Health and Human Services is proposing to readopt with amendment He-W 627.03 by:

- removing the term “medical” from the title;
- removing language defining a dependent child and instead citing to the rule; and
- making other editorial edits, including but not limited to, deleting a citation that is not specifically related to the rule language preceding the citation.

He-W 627.03 specifies the technical requirements for eligibility of financial assistance for families with older children as dependents as well as how eligibility will be determined for families once the family’s dependent is no longer defined as the dependents are in He-W 601.03(e)(3).

Readopt with amendment He-W 627.03, effective 7-26-12 (Document #10163), to read as follows:

He-W 627.03 Technical Requirements for Families With Older Children (FWOC) Category of Financial Assistance.

- (a) To be eligible for FWOC, an assistance group shall include at least one dependent child as defined in He-W 601.03(e)(3).
- (b) Applicants and recipients of FWOC shall include all dependent children described in He-W 601.03(e)(1) when they are counted in the assistance group.
- (c) Assistance groups receiving FWOC, which no longer include a dependent child as defined in He-W 601.03(e)(3), shall have eligibility determined for financial assistance to needy families (FANF), pursuant to He-W 600.
- (d) Recipients of FANF shall have eligibility automatically determined for FWOC when the oldest child in the assistance group turns 19.
