6. (a) Summary of what the rule says and of any proposed amendments:

The Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) is proposing to establish application-related fees for certain professions and facilities and to reserve the sections for which fees are not being established at this time so that once all of the fees are adopted, the professions will be in alphabetical order without excessive renumbering. Of the 44 sections in Part Plc 1002, 9 sections will establish fees and 35 sections will be reserved. Of the 9 sections that will establish fees, 5 sections are entirely new (Plc 1002.06, Plc 1002.13, Plc 1002.16, Plc 1002.42, and Plc 1002.44), 2 sections are existing Interim rules (Plc 1002.07, Plc 1002.26), one section is an expired Interim rule (Plc 1002.35, previously effective as Plc 1002.23), and one section is an expired Emergency rule (Plc 1002.10).

Application-related fees are proposed to be adopted or readopted for:

- The professions regulated by the Board of Barbering, Cosmetology, and Esthetics (new section):
- Microblading Certificates (existing Interim rule, no changes proposed);
- Inspections for sedation permits under the Board of Dental Examiners (expired Emergency rule, no changes from expired rule proposed);
- Electrologists (new section);
- The professions and facilities regulated by the Board of Registration of Funeral Directors and Embalmers (new section);
- Physician Assistants license renewal (existing Interim rule, no changes proposed);
- Pharmacy permits and mail-order pharmacy permits (expired Interim rule; the only changes proposed to the expired rule are the addition of the missing word "permit" in 2 places and adjustment of capitalization);
- The professions regulated by the OPLC with the Advisory Board of Reflexologists, Structural Integrators, and Asian Bodywork Therapists (new section); and
- The professions regulated by the Board of Veterinary Medicine (new section).

A draft of the rules was provided to the supported boards, commissions, and councils in the Fall of 2021, and comments received have been considered in determining the proposed fees.

The rules in Plc 1002 affect individuals and businesses who have or who wish to have a license to practice any of the professions identified in (a), above, and to any organization that wishes to become approved in New Hampshire as a school for electrology or for barbering, cosmetology, or esthetics.

3. Cost and benefits of the proposed rule(s):

The proposed rules contain the following fee changes and will have an indeterminable impact on the OPLC Fund, state citizens and independently owned business.

The expired emergency rule for Plc 1002.10 had the same fee amounts of \$750 for a comprehensive evaluation under Den 304.05 and \$300 for site visit under Den 304.05

as the proposed rule Plc 1002.10. Therefore, there is no difference in cost between the expired emergency rule and the proposed rule.

The expired interim rule for Plc 1002.23, which is Plc 1002.35 in the proposed rule, had the same fee amount of \$500 for an initial and renewal pharmacy permit and \$2,000 for an initial and renewal mail order pharmacy permit. Therefore, there is no difference in cost between the expired interim rule Plc 1002.23 and the proposed rule Plc 1002.35.

The proposed change in fee amounts are anticipated to generate an amount not to exceed 125% of actual cost for providing the service pursuant to RSA 310-A:1-e. There will be additional revenue to the State to the extent such fees are collected and deposited into the office of professional licensure and certification fund.

Note to the JLCAR. The JLCAR on 11-19-20 voted, when reviewing board rules, to support the Executive Director of the OPLC in possessing sole fee authority pursuant to RSA 310-A:1-d, II(h)(1) and RSA 310-A:1-e, I and II. SB 576, 2020, was to address the authority of the OPLC to establish fees for the licensing boards but it was tabled. The agency has been has been seeking a legislative fix the past few sessions to remove fee authority that still remains in boards' statutes, and SB 330, 2022, establishes a study committee to study the issue. SB 313 was introduced to fix some of these issues, however, there are still some outstanding issues that may require further legislation. Pursuant RSA 310-A:1-e, I. (a) the Executive Director of the OPLC has authority to assess certification, renewal fees, and any necessary administrative fees associated with licensing or certifications. However, it appears that some of the boards, commissions, councils, etc. still has fee authority pursuant to their own statutes.

328-F:3 Governing Boards Established; Board of Directors; Office of Licensed Allied Health Professionals. –

- I. There shall be established governing boards of athletic trainers, occupational therapists, recreational therapists, respiratory care practitioners, physical therapists, speech-language pathologists, hearing care providers, and genetic counselors.
- II. The governing boards' chairpersons or their appointees shall make up the board of directors of the office of licensed allied health professionals. The board of directors shall contract for the services of investigators and legal counsel retained through the office of professional licensure and certification. The board of directors shall have the authority to delegate to the person in the supervisory position matters of administrative and personnel management.
- III. There shall be an office of licensed allied health professionals established in Concord within the office of professional licensure and certification.
