

Good afternoon Senator Gray,

Per our discussions last week, you indicated that Portsmouth would need to move census blocks from Ward 2 into Ward 5.

In reviewing the census data with our GIS Department, we have moved 3 census blocks from Ward 2 into Ward 5, which relocates 131 people into Ward 5.

Below is a listing of the census blocks that were moved and the address ranges.

- **Census Block 2007 = 36 people**
- **Census Block 2026 = 31 people**
- **Census Block 2025 = 64 people**

- **Miller Avenue 250 – 396 (even side)**
- **Broad Street 177 – 295 (odd side)**
- **Lincoln Avenue 294-354 (even side)**
- **South Street 673 – 707 (odd side)**
- **Spring Street 29 – 39 (odd side)**
- **Spring Street 30 – 46 (even side)**
- **Bersum Lane (no addresses)**

Attached are two Portsmouth Ward Maps that outline the census blocks in blue that will be moved from Ward 2 into Ward 5.

Please review this data and advise if this meets the proper deviation recommended for Portsmouth.
