ICYMI: Senator Carson Testified in Support of SB 272

Concord, NH - Senator Carson released the following statement after testifying in support of SB 272 in the House Chamber to advocate for Parental Rights:

"Parents in New Hampshire love their children, they support their children, and above all, they want them to thrive," stated Senator Carson.

"Today I testified in support of my bill, SB 272, because it is not educators, but parents who have primary rights in the upbringing of children. School officials have only secondary responsibility and should respect the rights of New Hampshire parents.

"This bill helps parents be the best parents they can be, by offering their children the kind of love, support, and access to appropriate professional care that only families can provide. Our Parent's Bill of Rights in Education is essential in ensuring parents are provided with complete and accurate information impacting their children's development. SB 272 is about doing right by New Hampshire parents, doing right by New Hampshire students, and making sure parents have the information they need to raise healthy, thriving children.
