4. Must allow all sides to rebut findings as we gather them
5. Must search out and invite the true experts on this topic to testify before the Commission
6. Must synthesize our findings in an understandable report with actionable conclusions
7. Must resist making definitive statements to the press that sound like conclusions until we are done with our work
8. Must treat all witnesses with respect and question them in a respectful manner
9. Must allow interested parties in the audience to be heard in an informal manner, if time permits in any given meeting, but also allow the public to weigh in in a formal way
10. Must let facts lead us as we journey to understand the science
