PATRICK HERLIHY, Director, Bureau of Aeronautics, Rail and Transit, Department of Transportation: Thank you very much, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRMAN CHANDLER: There was a question on one of the reports that they do, which is really kind of -- is a little bit outdated now. That way if someone on the Committee wants to still get it, they can.

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MR. HERLIHY: Okay. Thank you, Mr. Chairman, Members of the Committee. For the record, my name is Patrick Herlihy. Director of Aeronautics, Rail, and Transit at the Department of Transportation. What I'm referring to is CAP 17-002, which is a Quarterly status report of all federal/local airport projects. This report came about as a budget footnote many years ago on an account which is our 2021 org code account which is for any money that we receive above and beyond what we had budgeted in the Capital Budget for FAA appropriations. We happen to have gotten two of those in the last, I don't know, probably 10 to 15 years. So these reports have been generated each quarter for that. I don't know if they're of any use to the Committee. We asked -- when we were asked to the Governor's Budget phase when we started the operating budget, we were asked were there any laws or footnotes we'd like to change. We put that in. It didn't make it through the Governor's phase. It was kept in there.

So we asked Finance Division II last week if they had an issue with us removing the budget footnote that requires this report, and they said that I should talk to Representative Chandler. So I talked to Representative Chandler and here I am now.

<u>CHAIRMAN CHANDLER</u>: I said it was okay; but then since we are having a meeting, I figure we might as well ask the other members.

 $\underline{\text{MR. HERLIHY}}$ : Right now we have one project on here. It's going to be completed on June 30<sup>th</sup>. We won't have any other projects in the foreseeable future on this. If the report is still something you'd be interested in, we could certainly do it if we get another project.

CHAIRMAN CHANDLER: That's what I was going to suggest. Why
don't you -- any members have any problems with that?

 $\underline{\text{MR. HERLIHY}}$ : I've never been questioned about this report. It's always just been an informational item, and there's never been any issue on it.

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<u>CHAIRMAN CHANDLER</u>: Anyone has a problem with taking that out and then just providing information when and if you do have a project? Okay.

FRANK BYRON, State Representative, Hillsborough County, District #20: Just a question, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRMAN CHANDLER: Yes.

<u>REP. BYRON</u>: Does this report go to anybody else other than this Committee?

MR. HERLIHY: Just this Committee.

<u>CHAIRMAN CHANDLER</u>: Okay. Go back to whoever you were speaking to in Finance and tell them to go ahead and take it out.

REP. EATON: Message delivered.

 $\underline{\text{MR. HERLIHY}}$ : Okay. Take it -- take the budget footnote out with the understanding that we'll still do a report if we get another project.

CHAIRMAN CHANDLER: Yes.

 $\underline{\text{MR. HERLIHY}}$ : Do you want to see additional reports on this project as we go forward? I mean, it should be done by June  $30^{\text{th}}$  which would be the end of this biennium any way. So there is one more report that's coming.

 $\underline{\text{CHAIRMAN CHANDLER}}\colon \text{Right.}$  That will be good. Just do that. That will be good.

CHAIRMAN CHANDLER: Thanks.

MR. HERLIHY: Thank you.
