RSA 228:12-a USE OF TOLL CREDITS:

<u>CAP 17-022 Department of Transportation</u> – Christopher Waszczuk, Deputy Commissioner, Department of Transportation, responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Senator Daniels, seconded by Representative Byron, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Planning and Community Assistance, to use \$2,168,250 of Turnpike Toll Credit, based on the \$10,841,250 estimated cost of all work efforts over the 2 year period to meet funding match requirements for; the proposed Statewide Planning and Research (SPR) Transportation Planning Work Program for 2018-2019, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated June 5, 2017.
