FIS 10-288 Department of Justice – On a motion by Senator Larsen, seconded by Representative Foose, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Justice to 1) retroactively amend the grant award termination date by extending the end date from August 31, 2010 to June 30, 2011, with no increase in funding (FIS 09-284, approved August 27, 2009) and reallocate \$19,000 in federal funds and 2) retroactively extend one (1) full-time temporary Program Specialist II position and retroactively extend the Consultant positions from August 31, 2010 to June 30, 2011 (FIS 09-284, approved August 27, 2009) and 3) to retroactively accept and expend \$197,974 in additional federal grant funds from September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. The Committee requested the Department provide additional information relative to New Hampshire's 16.6 percent prevalence of children with special health care needs and detail why it exceeds the national prevalence of 13.9 percent.

On a motion by Senator Larsen, seconded by Representative Foose, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to accept and expend \$190,623 in federal funds through June 30, 2011. MOTION ADOPTED.
