ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES:

On a motion by Representative Foose, seconded by Representative McGuire, that the minutes of the January 21, 2011 be accepted as written. MOTION ADOPTED.

On a motion by Representative Foose, seconded by Senator Bragdon, that the Committee approve the request under this section as submitted. MOTION ADOPTED. [FIS 11-074 Department of Health and Human Services – authorization to accept and expend \$8,239,135.91 in federal ARRA funds and decrease general funds in the amount of \$8,230,905 effective retroactive to July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 and further accept and expend \$28,375,469.12 in federal ARRA funds and decrease general funds in the amount of \$28,347,122 effective retroactive to July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011]

<u>FIS 11-043 Department of Transportation</u> – On a motion by Representative Foose, seconded by Senator Bragdon, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation to accept and expend revenue in the amount of \$536,490.54 from the Special Railroad Fund through June 30, 2011 and further expend an amount not to exceed \$536,490.54 for maintenance and repairs to active state-owned railroad lines through June 30, 2011. MOTION ADOPTED.

RSA 21-I:19-g, III, USE OF STATE-OWNED VEHICLES:

<u>FIS 11-078 Department of Administrative Services</u> – Linda Hodgdon, Commissioner, and Kevin Connor, Administrator, Department of Administrative Services, presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee. Deputy Adjutant General Stephen Burritt, The Adjutant General's Department, and Lorraine Merrill, Commissioner, Department of Agriculture were also present to respond to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative McGuire, seconded by Representative Stepanek, that the Committee study the request of the Department of Administrative Services for approval of 125 waivers and the denial of 7 waiver requests from various state agencies to retain state owned vehicles which were not used for travel at or above the break-even mileage requirement during FY 2010 for another month. No Action Taken.

On an amended motion by Representative Stepanek, seconded by Representative McGuire, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Administrative Services for the denial of 7 waiver requests from various state agencies to retain state owned vehicles which were not used for travel at or above the break-even mileage requirement during FY 2010 and withhold action on the Department's request for approval of 125 waivers. No Action Taken.

On a motion by Representative McGuire, seconded by Representative Stepanek, that the Committee grant a waiver authorizing the Adjutant General's Department to retain vehicle #2304641. MOTION ADOPTED. (7-Yes, 3-No)

On the previous amended motion by Representative Stepanek, seconded by Representative McGuire, that the Committee <u>amend</u> and approve the request of the Department of Administrative Services for the denial of <u>6</u>, <u>not 7</u>, waiver requests, from various state agencies to retain state owned vehicles which were not used for travel at or above the break-even mileage requirement during FY 2010 and table the Department's request for approval of 125 waivers. MOTION FAILS.

On a motion by Senator Bragdon, seconded by Representative Foose, that the Committee approve the original request of the Department of Administrative Services for approval of 125 waivers and the denial of 7 waiver requests from various state agencies to retain state owned vehicles which were not used for travel at or above the break-even mileage requirement during FY 2010, with the exception of the denial of the waiver for vehicle #2304641, which the Committee authorized the Adjutant General's Department to retain in a previous motion. MOTION ADOPTED. (9-Yes, 1-No)

The Chair appointed Representative McGuire as a subcommittee, with the option to recruit assistance from other members, to follow-up with the Department of Administrative Services the waiver requests to retain state owned vehicles which were not used for travel at or above the break-even mileage requirement during FY 2010.
