The Fiscal Committee of the General Court met on Friday, January 22, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 210-211 of the Legislative Office Building.

OLD BUSINESS:

<u>FIS 10-023 Department of Administrative Services</u> – Linda Hodgdon, Commissioner, and Edgar Carter, State Comptroller, Department of Administrative Services, and Catherine Provencher, State Treasurer, presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Representative Foose, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Administrative Services to transfer \$79,733,929 from the Revenue Stabilization Reserve Account to the General Fund Surplus for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2009 to eliminate the General Fund operating deficit, which was rescheduled January 8, 2010. MOTION ADOPTED.

On a motion by Senator Bragdon, seconded by Representative Kurk, that the Committee recommend to the legislature that any amounts received from the New Hampshire Medical Malpractice Joint Underwriting Association (JUA), should the State win, be transferred to the Revenue Stabilization Reserve Account until such time as the amount transferred equals \$65 million. MOTION ADOPTED.
