FISCAL COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL COURT MINUTES - EMERGENCY MEETING May 19, 2006

Chairman King opened the meeting at 12:10 p.m. and indicated that he had received a letter directed to the Fiscal Committee from the Governor requesting this meeting, and that Governor Lynch was present to explain the purpose of this meeting. Chairman King explained that under RSA 91-A:2, the Right-to-Know Law, an emergency meeting can be called and such a meeting does not require a 24-hour notice. Chairman King further explained that notices were posted in various locations throughout the building, and in all elevators in the State House and Legislative Office Building.

On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Representative Hager, that the Committee approve the request from the Office of the Governor to draw up to \$5,000,000 from funds not otherwise appropriated, and deposit these funds in the Department of Safety, Bureau of Emergency Management's account, as are necessary to deal with the current civil emergency due to recent flooding, as specified in his letter dated May 18, 2006.
