MOTION ADOPTED. (8-Yes, 1-No)

<u>FIS 07-375 Department of Justice</u> – Orville B. Fitch, Deputy Attorney General, and Rosemary Faretra, Director of Administration, presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Representative Eaton, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Justice to accept and expend a charitable trust grant from PEW Charitable Trusts in the amount of \$189,500. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>FIS 07-374 Office of Energy and Planning</u> – On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the request of the Office of Energy and Planning to budget and expend \$569,259 in prior year carry forward funds through June 30, 2009. MOTION ADOPTED. (9-Yes, 1-No)
