MINUTES

December 13, 2007

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES:

On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative King, that the minutes of the November 14, 2007 be accepted as written. MOTION ADOPTED.

RESULTS OF TELEPHONE POLL HELD DECEMBER 4, 2007:

FIS 07-391 Department of Labor - On a motion by Representative King, seconded by Senator Larsen, that the Committee ratify the poll results taken by telephone December 4, 2007 unanimously approving the request from the Department of Labor to retroactively accept and expend \$659,992 in federal funds from November 19, 2007 to June 30, 2009 on behalf of the Workforce Opportunity Council, Inc., Concord, N.H. MOTION ADOPTED.

George Copadis, Commissioner, Department of Labor and Cindy Naiditch, Executive Director of the Workforce Opportunity Council, Inc. thanked the Committee for their quick response on this item.

OLD BUSINESS:

FIS 07-111 Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Medicaid Business and Policy – for authorization to clarify physician services reimbursements to comply with recent instructions from the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). <u>Tabled</u> 4/19/07 and 5/15/07. No action taken.

FIS 07-238 Department of Health and Human Services – authorization to complete the bid process for the GraniteCare Selective Contracting Program. <u>Tabled 7/24/07</u>. No action taken.

<u>FIS 07-342 Department of Administrative Services</u> – request for various departments to retain state owned passenger automobiles with FY 2007 reported mileage less than 12,000 miles. **Tabled 11/14/07**. No action taken.

FIS 07-371 Department of Transportation – accept and expend \$900,000 <u>Tabled</u> <u>11/14/07</u>. Jeffry Pattison, Deputy Legislative Budget Assistant, informed the Committee that the Department of Transportation requested that the item be withdrawn.

On a motion by Representative King, seconded by Senator Larsen, that the Committee accept the request of the Department of Transportation to withdraw the item. MOTION ADOPTED.

FIS 07-381 Department of Health and Human Services, Tobey School – On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Representative Franklin, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services, Tobey School, to accept and expend agency income in the amount of \$279,604 for renovations of space at the Thayer Building through June 30, 2008. MOTION ADOPTED.

MOTION ADOPTED.

CHAPTER 263:28, II AND III, LAWS OF 2007, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES; PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY; ADDITIONAL REVENUES; TRANSFER AMONG ACCOUNTS:

<u>FIS 07-382 Department of Health and Human Services</u> – Nicholas Toumpas, Commissioner, Kathryn Frey, Administrator II, Public Health Services, and Mary Holliday, Administrator II, Division of Public Health Laboratories, Department of Health and Human Services responded to questions of the Committee. Also present was Richard Bailey, Chief Information Officer, Office of Information Technology who responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Senator Larsen, seconded by Representative Eaton, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to accept additional laboratory fees in the amount of \$500,000 as unrestricted revenue and further authorization to transfer and allocate \$500,000 of additional unrestricted revenue. MOTION WITHDRAWN.

Commissioner Toumpas requested to withdraw the request. On a motion by Senator Larsen, seconded by Representative Eaton, that the Committee accept the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to withdraw the item. MOTION ADOPTED.

FIS 07-389 Department of Health and Human Services – On a motion by Representative King, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to accept and expend \$64,268 in other funds from the N.H. Department of Safety and further authorization to allocate these funds among Department of Health and Human Services accounts. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>FIS 07-393 Department of Safety</u> – Wesley Colby, Director, Division of Administration, Department of Safety, responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Franklin, that Committee approve the request of the Department of Safety to eliminate open position #10364 and establish three (3) Secretary II LG 9 positions in the Bureau of Hearings through June 30, 2009. MOTION ADOPTED.

Michael Buckley, Legislative Budget Assistant, requested authority to release publicly the 2007 State Comprehensive Annual Financial Report and the 2007 Unique College Investing Plan Annual Report as soon as they are available.

On a motion by Representative Kurk, seconded by Senator Larsen, that the Committee grant authority to the Legislative Budget Assistant to distribute the 2007 State Comprehensive Annual Financial Report and the 2007 Unique College Investing Plan Annual Report upon their receipt by the Office of Legislative Budget Assistant. MOTION ADOPTED.
