Senate Honors Officer Bradley Haas

CONCORD, NH – Senator Dan Innis (R-Bradford) and Senator Denise Riccardi (R-Bedford) issued the following joint statement today on the Senate passing of SB 592-FN, renaming Route 127 from Central Street in Franklin to the town line of Sanbornton as Officer Bradley Haas Memorial Highway:

“I want to thank my colleagues for honoring Officer Bradley Haas for his brave sacrifice. Officer Bradley’s heroic life, his love his fellow citizens, and his protective mission will always be remembered,” said Senator Innis.

“Officer Bradley Haas gave his life protecting Granite Staters last November. We honor him by naming a portion of Route 127 from Central Street in Franklin to the town line of Sanbornton the Officer Bradley Haas Memorial Highway,” added Senator Riccardi.

Background: Officer Bradley Haas was from Franklin and spent three years as a military police officer in the U.S. Army. Haas served with the Franklin Police Department for 28 years as a patrol officer and eventually became police chief. Haas retired in 2008 before going to work for New Hampshire Hospital as a security officer. Haas was killed protecting Granite Staters at New Hampshire Hospital in Concord on November 17th, 2023.
