April 20, 2020

The Fiscal Committee of the General Court met on Monday, April 20, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. via audio conference.

Representative Ford, Acting Clerk, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. with the assistance of Fallon Reed at the Department of Safety and Michael Kane, Legislative Budget Assistant, and recessed until 11:00 a.m.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Michael Kane, Legislative Budget Assistant, presented an update on the United States Department of the Treasury guidance relative to use of Coronavirus Relief Funds under the CARES Act of which New Hampshire is eligible for \$1.25 billion and responded to Committee questions.

On a motion by Senator Rosenwald, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the following motion;

"In light of the Governor's Office statement that the \$26 million in transfers from various programs in the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) were for "cash flow" purposes to pay COVID-19 expenses, and the fact that the State has since received \$625 million in CARES Funds on Friday, April 17, 2020, to the extent U.S. Treasury guidance permits, the Fiscal Committee moves to reverse the following transfers made by DHHS:

- \$8 million from Substance Use Disorder rate increases;
- \$4 million from the State Loan Repayment Program for health care workers;
- \$1.7 million from homeless shelter and re-housing;
- \$8.75 million from the new Secure Psychiatric Unit;
- \$2 million from low income senior prescription drug assistance;
- \$750 thousand from congregate housing;
- \$750 thousand in additional transfers for the Secure Psychiatric Unit, and
- \$100 thousand from the Foster Grandparents Program."
