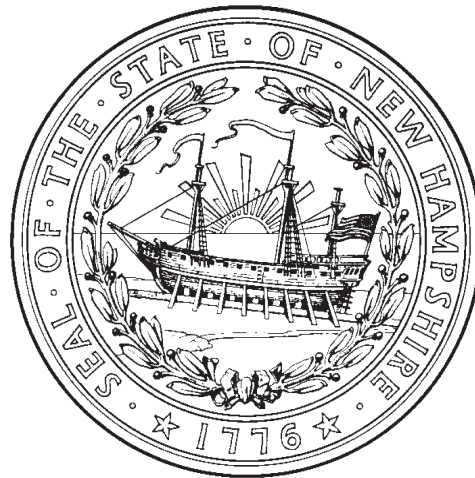

On 12/29/22, the Internal Revenue Service modified the standard mileage rate for transportation expenses.
