#### **METHODOLOGY:**

This bill establishes a \$250,000 general fund appropriation, nonlapsing until June 30,2026, for fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 to the Department of Business and Economic Affairs. The funds shall be allocated towards recruiting and training small business development counselors for the small business development center in rural areas of New Hampshire.

The Department of Business and Economic Affairs states once they receive the \$250,000 appropriation, they will pass the funds onto the small business development centers resulting in an increase in general fund expenditures in FY 2025.
