AN ACT relative to the definition of broadband infrastructure as a revenue-producing facility eligible for municipal revenue bonds.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill alters broadband municipal revenue bonding restrictions to be limited to formed communications districts and specifies the rates of transmission in the definition of broadband.

AN ACT relative to the definition of broadband infrastructure as a revenue-producing facility eligible for municipal revenue bonds.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Municipal Revenue Bonds; Definitions. Amend RSA 33-B:1, VI to read as follows:

2 VI. "Revenue-producing facilities" means water works, broadband infrastructure as defined
3 in RSA 38:38, I(e), purchased or constructed to serve any location within a municipality unserved by
4 broadband as defined in RSA 38:38, I(c) **or any location within a communications district**
5 **formed under RSA 53-G**, sewerage systems, sewage treatment or disposal facilities, solid waste
6 disposal or resource recovery facilities, parking facilities, facilities for the production, generation,
7 transmission, or distribution of electricity or gas, any other real or personal property or interests in a
8 municipality or regional water district owned or controlled by the municipality or regional water
9 district, from the operation of which revenues are or are expected to be derived by the municipality,
10 or regional water district, and qualifying energy conservation and clean energy improvements for
11 which a municipality provides financing pursuant to RSA 53-F.

12 2 Municipal Electric, Gas, or Water Systems; Broadband Access; Broadband. Amend RSA 38:38,
13 I(c) to read as follows:

14 (c) "Broadband" means the transmission of information, between or among points
15 specified by the user, with or without change in the form or content of the information as sent and
16 received, at rates of transmission **greater than or equal to 100 megabits per second download**
17 **and 20 megabits per second upload or at rates of transmission** defined by the Federal
18 Communications Commission as a wireline advanced telecommunications capability as defined by
19 section 706 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, **whichever rates of transmission are greater**,
20 irrespective of the network technology used.

21 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
