10 Amend RSA 674:36, IV as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

12 IV. The planning board limitations under this section shall not require letter of 13 credit, cash, or passbook as the only method securing the completion of the work. A 14 planning board shall allow road and utility construction to start without a bond, however, 15 a bond for the infrastructure, roads, and utilities must be in place prior to the sale of any 16 parcel of land within the subdivision or a request for a building permit for structures for 17 human occupation. The planning board shall not require that forfeiture or automatic call 18 bonds be provided by the developer.
