STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Three*

AN ACT establishing a committee to study electrical vehicle charging for residential renters.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1 81:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study electrical vehicle charging  
2 for residential renters.

3 81:2 Membership and Compensation.

4 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5 (a) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of  
6 representatives.

7 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to the  
9 duties of the committee.

10 81:3 Duties. The committee shall study accessibility and opportunities to provide electrical vehicle  
11 charging for residential renters.

12 81:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from  
13 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house  
14 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this  
15 section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

16 81:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed  
17 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house clerk, the  
18 senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2023.

81:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
