STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Three

AN ACT establishing a committee to study unlimited service area permits for landfills and out of state waste coming into New Hampshire.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 100:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study unlimited service area
2 permits for landfills and out of state waste coming into New Hampshire.

3 100:2 Membership and Compensation.

4 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5 (a) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

6 (b) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of
7 representatives.

8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to the
9 duties of the committee.

10 100:3 Duties. The committee shall study unlimited service area permits for landfills and out of state
11 waste coming into New Hampshire.

12 100:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
13 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the senate member. The first
14 meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section. Three
15 members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

16 100:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
17 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate clerk,
18 the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2023.

19 100:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
