Amendment to HB 232-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 AN ACT making an appropriation to the department of labor for the purpose of reviewing workers' occupational safety requirements.

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Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

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Appropriation; Department of Labor; Occupational Safety Regulations; Additional Staffing Requirement. Pursuant to RSA 277, the labor commissioner is required to adopt rules to regulate worker safety for employees of the state and its political subdivisions. These rules are due to expire in 2025, and changes in safety requirements and enforcement are likely to require extensive reevaluation of the existing rules, which will require additional staff and resources. To meet this responsibility, the labor commissioner may establish up to 3 additional full-time positions for the purpose of conducting a full and timely review of administrative rules Lab 1400, relative to safety and health of employees. The salary and benefits for such positions shall not exceed \$400,000 and shall be a charge against the department of labor administration fund under RSA 281-A:59 or the restricted fund under RSA 273:1-b, in proportions and amounts proposed by the labor commissioner and approved by the legislative fiscal committee.

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill authorizes the labor commissioner to establish up to 3 additional positions for the purpose of conducting a review and update of administrative rules related to worker occupational safety. The positions shall be funded through the department of labor administration fund and restricted fund.
